### **GOALS & INDICATORS**

### GOAL # 1:

**Reading/Writing Goal**: Currently, at Arbor View School, 84.6% of students are above the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and 62.3% of all students met or exceeded their growth targets based on ELA Spring 2014 NWEA/MAP data. By spring 2016, 87% of Arbor View students will be above the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and 65% of all students will have met or exceeded their growth targets based on ELA Spring 2016 NWEA/MAP data. (Aligned to Strategic Plan Goal #1)

Grade PreK: 80% of year four students will be able to identify 20-25 upper case letters. Grade K: 90% of students will be able to name 39 letter sounds in 1 minute, 90% will read an F/P level D.

Grade 1: 89% of students will be above the 40% tile based on NWEA/MAP

Grade 2: 80% of students will meet/exceed their growth targets.

Grade 3: 80% of students will meet/exceed their growth targets.

Grade 4: 80% of their students will meet or exceed on each CCSS Standards

Grade 5: Based on standards based pretest data, the summative assessment class average (mean of percent correct per standard) will improve by 10 percentage points.

## GOAL # 2:

**Math Goal:** Currently, at Arbor View School, 85% of students are above the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and 72.5% of all students met or exceeded their growth targets based on math Spring 2015 NWEA/MAP data. By spring 2016, 90% of Arbor View students will be above the 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and 75% of all students will



have met or exceeded their growth targets based on math Spring 2016 NWEA/MAP data. (Aligned to Strategic Plan Goal #1)

Grade K: 90% of students will meet Envisions benchmark standards by the end of year. Grade 1: 92% of students will be above the 40%tile based on NWEA/MAP Grade 2: 80% of students will meet/exceed their growth targets. Grade 3: 80% of students will meet/exceed their growth targets. Grade 4: 80% of their students will meet or exceed on each CCSS Standards Grade 5: Based on standards based pretest data, the summative assessment class average (mean of percent correct per standard) will improve by 10 percentage points.
