DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Gifted/Advanced Learning program update (*BOE Goal: Continuous Improvement.*) Dr. Kingsfield and Mr. Eccarius provided a draft vision and tentative action steps for Board discussion. In May 2023, CCSD 89 began a comprehensive review of the district's gifted and advanced learning programs. The audit and feedback identified areas for potential growth in several categories, including student identification, expanded advanced opportunities and student scheduling.
- Superintendent's Committee Assignments (*BOE Goal: Continuous Improvement.*) Board members and Superintendent Eccarius discussed and selected their committee assignments for the 2025-2027 school year.
